INTRODUCING THE ACL TRUST

As the producing station of Austin City Limits (ACL) for over 50 years, Austin PBS has established the ACL Trust - a dedicated, reserve fund designed to ensure the beloved series will be sustained long-term. Our initial goal is to raise \$6 million over the first three years to build a reserve to support future production and operations.



THE LONGEST-RUNNING MUSIC TELEVISION SERIES

For over 50 years, ACL has helped define Austin's creative identity by featuring legendary artists, elevating emerging talent, and sharing live music with the world.

- Generates 38% of Austin PBS's annual operating budget
- Elevates Austin's reputation globally as the Live Music Capital of the World
- Enhances Austin's creative ecosystem and music economy

ACL & AUSTIN PBS: CONTINUING THE LEGACY

Austin PBS (KLRU-TV) is the region's only locally owned broadcast station, delivering free, high-quality educational programming, cultural storytelling, and trusted news—especially for families without paid cable or streaming. ACL is Austin PBS's flagship series and The ACL Trust ensures its continued success while protecting the essential services Austin PBS provides to Central Texas.

As public media navigates a new normal after the elimination of federal funding, this fund will help safeguard the programming, education, and storytelling unique to our region that our community depends on.



IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

- 3 million Central Texans served across 20+ counties
- 12% of Austin PBS' \$21M annual budget lost due to the elimination of federal funding

HOW THE ACL TRUST WORKS

The ACL Trust is a dedicated reserve created to ensure long-term stability for Austin City Limits. Funds are managed with Board oversight, financial controls and clear spending policies. Raised funds are intended to build and maintain a reserve to ensure ACL remains in the homes across the country for another 50 years and beyond.

- A reserve fund, not an annual operating budget
- Provides continuity if traditional funding fluctuates
- Creates opportunities for specialized programming
- Restricted to all costs related to ACL TV

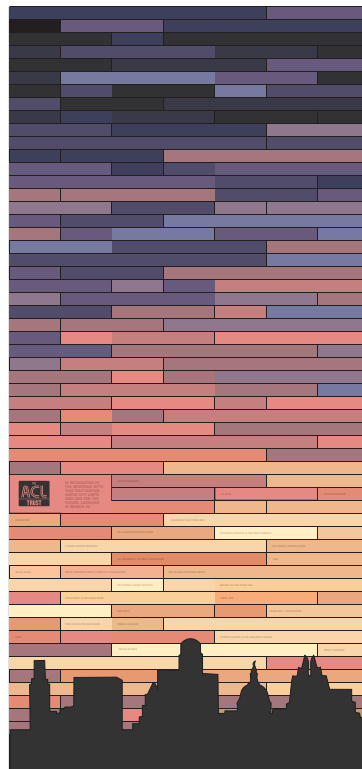
